FRENCH

Where is French spoken?

In several countries of Europe: France, Belgium, Luxembourg, Switzerland, Monaco; Canada (Quebec); French Guayana, on several Caribbean islands (Martinique, Haiti); and in French Polynesia.

French is also a second language in many parts of Africa and in former French Indochina. French is spoken as a minority language in parts of the U.S., chiefly New England and Louisiana.

French is also a language of diplomacy and one of the major languages used at the United Nations.

GERMAN

Where is German spoken?

German is an official language in five European countries: The Federal Republic of Germany, Austria, Switzerland, Luxembourg, and Liechtenstein. German is spoken in scattered minority communities in Eastern Europe and North and South America. Yiddish is also a dialect of German.

LATIN

Where is Latin used?

Latin is no longer spoken, although it is still used for communication in the Catholic church on a limited basis. It is still widely studied throughout Europe, as well as North and South America because of its outstanding literature and because it is the basis of much of the modern Western language and culture.

What are other reasons to study Latin?

- •Many terms in medicine and biological sciences come directly from Latin. For this reason, medical schools have traditionally required some study of Latin for graduation.
- •Many legal terms (habeas corpus, amicus curlae, subpoena, etc.) are Latin.
- •Studying Latin can help increase your English vocabulary and improve your score on college entrance tests, such as the SAT.

Modern languages such as Spanish, French, and Portuguese come directly from Latin. Other languages, such as English, German, and even Russian have large numbers of Latin-based words. In addition, study of Latin helps you to understand how languages work. Because of all this, learning Latin makes a good preparation for learning modern languages too.

•Studying Latin increases your knowledge of Graeco-Roman Civilization and its contribution to modern society.

SPANISH

Where is Spanish spoken?

In Spain, and in most countries of Central and South America, and as a significant minority language in many communities in the United States.
